## SUGGESTED INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SHELF

*Important:* Please read the following instructions before you begin installation. It is the responsibility of the consumer to ensure this product is installed safely and accurately. If you do not feel you can complete this installation safely, it is recommended to seek a professional.

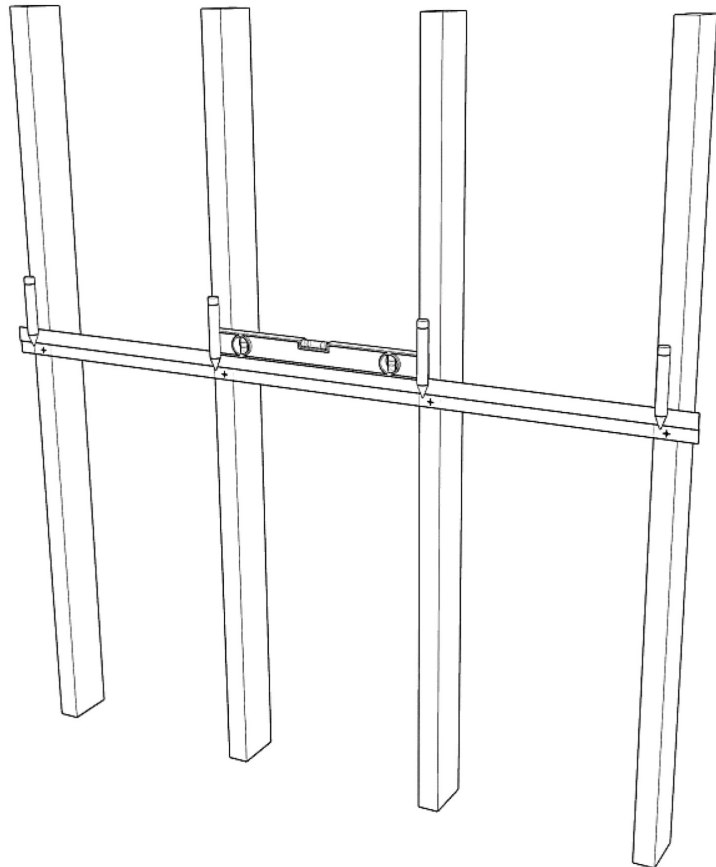

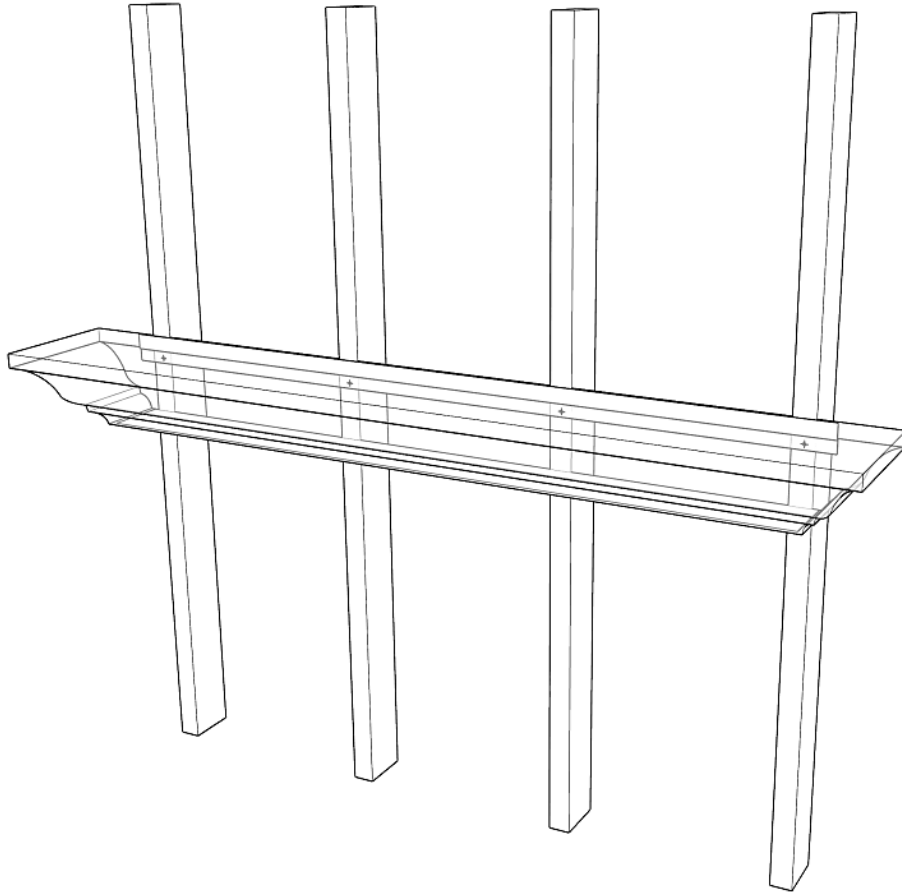
- Tape Measure

### SHELF INSTALLATION

**Step 1** - Hold the metal mounting bar on the wall where you want the shelf to be installed. The top of the shelf will sit flush on top of the mounting bar. Find the position of the studs in the wall and mark where they are located. The holes in the mounting bar should match up to the studs in the wall. These marks will be the reference points for installing the mounting bar. Set a level on top of the bar to make sure it is level.



**Step 2** - Line the metal bar up to the pencil marks, and, using a screwdriver, screw the wood screws into each hole of the mounting bar. (Optional: using a smaller drill bit, you can first pre-drill holes for the wood screws to go into to prevent any splitting.)



**Step 3** - Slide the shelf over the metal bar that is now mounted on the wall and press down firmly until the shelf is secure.

If installing into masonry: use lag bolts and anchor them to the wall through proper sized holes drilled in the bracket. It is important to use flat head masonry lag bolts so that the mantle fits flush against the bracket and does not wedge against the back of the mantle and push the mantle away from the wall. Note: There are many different masonry bolts and anchors available, be sure to choose the appropriate ones for your wall. (brick, cement, block).

If installing into drywall: please take caution when hanging your shelf. Drywall anchors are provided for light duty installation only. Specialty use that requires weight on the mantle (i.e. books) should be done with heavy duty drywall anchors (such as toggle bolts or expanding metal hollow wall anchors.) Due to the many varieties of drywall anchors, please choose the appropriate ones for your wall and application.
